Conflict Minerals Statement

Wall Colmonoy is committed to responsible sourcing and maintaining a socially and environmentally responsible supply chain. We recognise the serious concerns associated with the mining of certain minerals, specifically tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (3TG), that may originate from conflict-affected and high-risk areas. The trade of these minerals has been linked to financing armed groups, contributing to human rights abuses, and causing significant environmental harm.

In line with international best practices, including the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals and the initiatives of the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI), Wall Colmonoy works with its suppliers to promote ethical sourcing and transparency. We require our suppliers to confirm, through the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT), that the materials they provide to us are not sourced from operations that directly or indirectly support armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining regions.

To support this commitment, Wall Colmonoy:

- Communicates our expectations on conflict minerals to suppliers.
- Requests and reviews CMRT submissions from relevant suppliers.
- Engages with suppliers to improve transparency in the mineral supply chain.
- Monitors developments in legislation and industry best practices to strengthen our approach.
